From 1st January, AXELOS has become the official accreditor for the Global Best Practice portfolio, which includes ITIL and PRINCE2.

ITIL is the most recognized framework for IT service management in the world. Exams are available in 21 languages in more than 150 countries. Among the organizations to adopt ITIL best practice is Disney, which employs thousands of IT professionals worldwide.

PRINCE2 is one of the best known and most successful project management methods. To date, more than one million exams have been taken in more than 120 countries.

The portfolio also includes Managing Successful Programmes (MSP®), which was used by project managers at the Government Olympic Executive for the London 2012 Olympic and Paralympic Games.

As well as setting up the new business infrastructure over the past few months, there has been a number of major milestones announced including:

- confirmation of the successful Examination Institutes (EIs) to operate all Global Best Practice exam schemes
- confirmation that the Accredited Consulting Organization (ACO) scheme will continue in 2014
- confirmation that the ITIL Software scheme will continue in 2014
- memorandum of understanding reached between AXELOS and itSMF International, outlining how the two organizations will work together
- launch of the ITIL Maturity Model and self-assessment service
- launch of the Official ITIL Foundation Exam App.

Peter Hepworth added *'We have built the foundations of a solid business to manage the growth of what is clearly a well respected and valued portfolio. 2014 is set to be another exciting year full of challenges and I look forward to announcing further developments and additions.'*
